



# Building Bridges: A Decade of Collaboration between Business Faculty and Library Services for Enhanced Student Learning

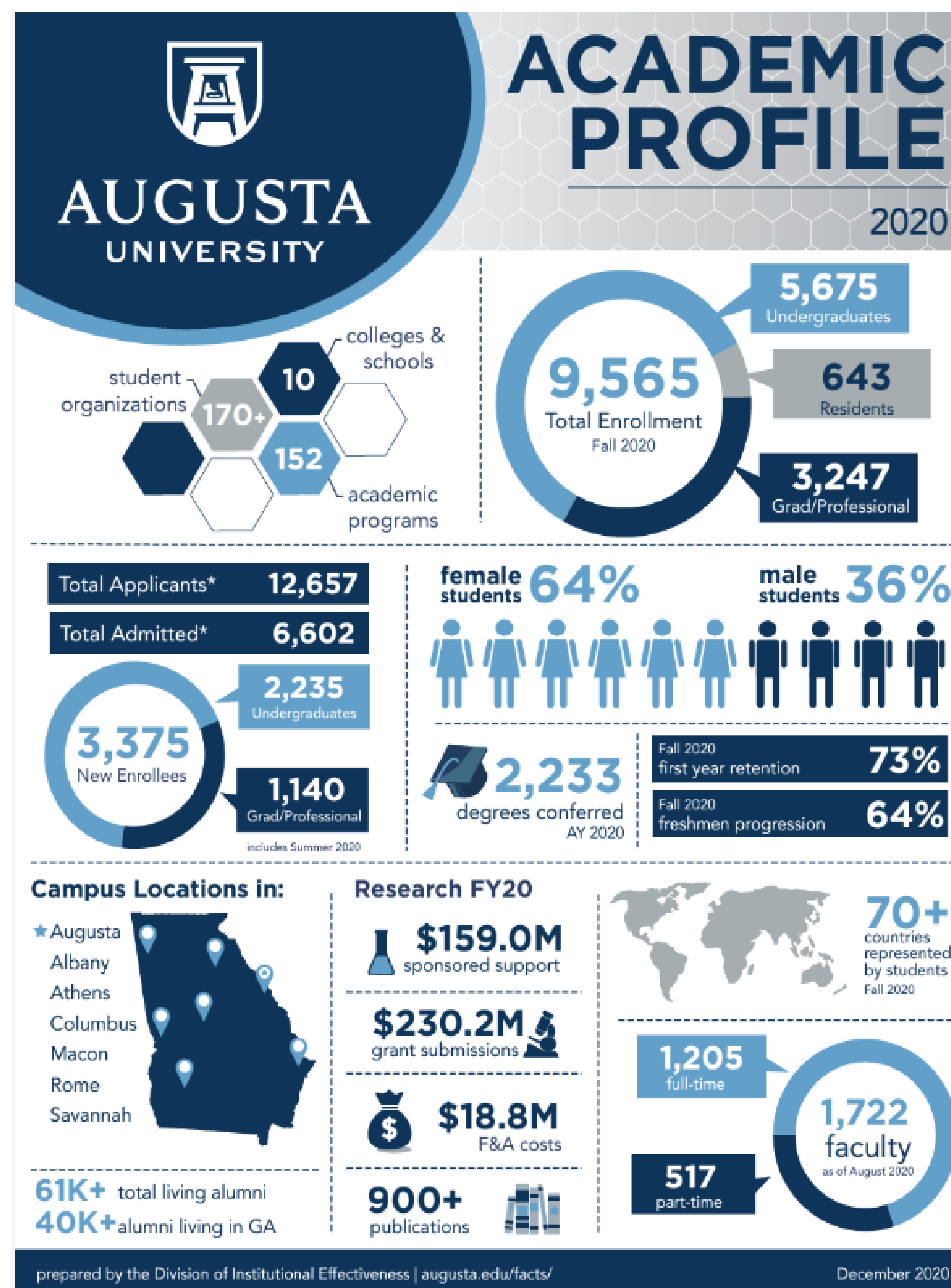
